Dear Residents, Families and Team Members of Auburn Hill Senior Living,

I hope that everyone had a wonderful Christmas! I wanted to give you an update on COVID status here at Auburn Hill. We have 3 team members who have positive test results. Two of the team members are currently at home on quarantine. We were able to identify the residents at the highest risk of exposure and the families and residents have been notified. We will test those identified residents today and retest in 5-7 days. We continue to screen residents daily for any signs or symptoms of COVID. We have notified the department of health and will adjust our plan based on any additional recommendations.

The third team member developed symptoms and subsequently tested positive for COVID while at home during their vacation time off and remains on quarantine. Due to the timeline, there was not an exposure to the community, but we wanted to communicate this as well.

Team members are required to wear masks while in the community. As a reminder, visitors are required to wear masks while entering the community and may remove them once in the apartments if both parties are vaccinated. Please do not visit the community if you are experiencing any signs or symptoms of COVID.

It's unfortunate that we are still navigating through the waters of COVID, but we will continue to do so as long as it takes! Please do not hesitate to reach out to us with any questions that you have.
