Dear Residents, Families and Team Members of Auburn Hill Senior Living,

I wanted to provide a COVID update here at Auburn Hill. We have a team member who has tested positive for COVID and remains at home on isolation. We have identified potential exposure to residents in assisted living (floors 1-3). We will plan to test all AL residents and any identified team members on Monday based on the post exposure length of time.

Team members are required to wear masks while in the community. As a reminder, visitors are required to wear masks while entering the community and may remove them once in the apartments if both parties are vaccinated. Please remember that visitations must occur in the apartments or outside. Restrictions for visitation in common areas, activities, and dining are still in place. Please do not visit the community if you are experiencing any signs or symptoms of COVID.

There are no changes to our COVID protocols at this time. We will communicate any changes to residents, families, and team members. We are in the process of reviewing lifted visitation restrictions for activities and common areas.
