Dear friends and families,

At Auburn Hill Senior Living we continue to follow guidance from the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) as well as continue to hold the safety of our residents as the highest priority as well as maintaining the understanding that our seniors remain as the most vulnerable population.

We are working towards safety measures to allow for our residents to meet and engage together in more of a communal setting, especially during activities and dining. We are currently working alongside the VDH and National Guard to initiate a Point Prevalence Survey, a baseline COVID test, before advancing our opening phase, as recommended by the VDH. As we finalize details, there will be notification to residents, families, and team members of the date this will occur and any additional details of this process. In addition to this, there will be a consent form for the COVID-19 test to be given to every resident and/or the responsible party for those who require assistance with making medical decisions.

At this time, we have to keep our restrictions and processes in place, including continuing the “no visitation” rule, social distancing, screening all residents and staff daily, and enforcing mask-wearing by staff and residents. We continue to restrict community dining and activities to resident’s rooms at this time. We understand entirely you are missing your loved ones; however, we feel keeping these essential measures in place will continue to keep our residents safe with the hope one day soon to ease back into our healthy life.

We are thankful for our team members who are being so careful and our family members who support the restrictions we have put in place. A special thank you to all that have supported our community during this current time.
