Hello Auburn Hill Residents, Families, and Team!

I wanted to let you know that we are still waiting on a COVID-19 vaccination clinic date from CVS. We have been assigned a point of contact, so things are moving along.

To prepare for our vaccination date, I am attaching some documents for you to begin reviewing and completing.

- The first form is the **COVID-19 Responsible Party Consent Form**. This form is for those residents who are unable to sign for themselves. This will require the signature of the responsible party.
- The second form is the **COVID-19 Vaccine Intake Consent Form**. Our team here can assist residents with completion of this form. For those residents who cannot sign for themselves, the community will fill out the form, we need the signature of the responsible party on the yellow highlighted area.
- If you are able to sign these documents and scan them to e-mail them back to me at ed.ahs@auburnhillliving.com that would be great. If you don't have scanning capabilities, the documents can be dropped off at the building or mailed back to us. We do need them as quickly as possible.

I have also attached information regarding the vaccination, which will be provided to residents and employees so informed consents can be made. Please reach out to us should you have any questions.

I know that everyone is excited about our negative COVID status here at Auburn Hill, we share in the excitement with you! However, please remember that we will need to phase back into lifting restrictions slowly. With that said, indoor visitations remain restricted at this time.

We thought we would try something different this time, to avoid our residents being exposed to the colder weather outside. We will be utilizing an unoccupied apartment on the 2nd floor (main entrance) and will be placing a phone in there so residents may utilize that space for a "window" visit while speaking on the phone to their loved ones outside. There is a dedicated phone number that will be provided to you as you schedule your visit through the concierge. If you have any additional questions, please contact Ashley Nagle, Activities Director at 804-456-4455. We will continue to offer video chats as well.

Starting Monday we will be having one meal in the dining room, the lunchtime meal. We will also be scheduling one activity twice a day and a scheduled movie per our Assisted Living residents' request! Communication will be sent as we begin to allow for more communal activities.
