Just another update coming your way from Auburn Hill! We have a busy week ahead of us! Our team and residents have been tested for COVID-19. We have one additional team member with positive results. We currently have one resident with positive results, and two team members with positive results who remain at home on quarantine.

In review and discussion with Virginia Department of Health (VDH), Auburn Hill is not currently considered an “outbreak” community. However, to best manage this and to better determine our status, additional testing is recommended.

We are in the process of coordinating testing with the help of VDH and the National Guard for this Thursday January 14, 2021. Any changes to this date will be communicated with everyone. Results of this testing will determine future recommended testing plans.

We are still on schedule for our first vaccine clinic with CVS tomorrow from 10am-4pm. Thank you to everyone for your prompt response with the consents, it has made this process easier for us.

You all remain amazing to work with throughout this pandemic. Your level of understanding support and appreciation is so important to us. It really helps us on those more challenging days!
