Dear Residents, Friends, and Families,

Governor Northam and the COVID-19 Long-Term Care Task Force have initiated the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) Point Prevalence Survey Project in response to the impact COVID-19 is having on Long-Term Care Communities. A Point Prevalence Survey (PPS) is currently being scheduled with the National Guard and entails testing of all residents and team members of the community, regardless of presence of symptoms.

While we still have no positive cases, data from communities across the country to date suggests that there are often positive but asymptomatic residents and team members, which can contribute to silent transmissions. The results will inform the Community's leadership team about the extent and distribution of infection with the virus that causes COVID-19 and will serve as a baseline for any additional testing. A PPS is a powerful tool that can be used to intervene early in outbreaks and can help guide decisions regarding reopening.

We have received communication from the Epidemiologist at the Chesterfield County Health Department today that they are currently working on the coordination and scheduling of the PPS for Auburn Hill.

To better be prepared we are sending out consent forms for the COVID-19 test now so when we are given a scheduled date, we have everything in place. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact me and we will keep you informed of a testing date.
